CRIDDLE ADVISED THAT HE HAD RECEIVED TO PHONE CALLS FROM ROGER TYRONE JAMES AT APPROXIMATELY AROUND 0230 HOURS ON THE DAY OF THE INCIDENT.

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DURING THE FIRST PHONE CALL, JAMES WAS BEING BELLIGERENT AND ASKING WHO CRIDDLE WAS TO KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK. CRIDDLE STATED THAT HE ADVISED JAMES THAT IT WAS NONE OF HIS BUSINESS AND DID NOT SAY ANYTHING ELSE BECAUSE HE DID NOT WANT TO CAUSE MORE PROBLEMS. CRIDDLE STATED THE CALL ENDED WHEN HE HUNG UP ON JAMES. JAMES CALLED AGAIN AND AGAIN WAS BELLIGERENT. CRIDDLE ADVISED HE DID NOT SAY ANYTHING AND ENDED THE CALL BY HANGING UP. CRIDDLE STATED HE KNEW WHO WAS CALLING BECAUSE HE WAS CALLING FROM KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK'S PHONE.

CRIDDLE THEN ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK VIA TELEPHONE APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR LATER. HE THEN SENT A TEXT MESSAGE A LITTLE LATER AGAIN TRYING TO CONTACT HER.

CRIDDLE ADVISED THAT HE WAS AWARE OF THE INCIDENT BECAUSE KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK HAD CONTACTED HIM AROUND 1100 TO 1300 HOURS ON THE DAY OF THE INCIDENT. CRIDDLE STATED THAT SHE INFORMED HIM OF THE INCIDENT. CRIDDLE STATED HE BELIEVED HE RECEIVED THE CALLS FROM ROGER TYRONE JAMES BECAUSE HE WAS DRUNK AGAIN AND JAMES AND KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK HAD ALTERCATIONS BEFORE. CRIDDLE STATED THAT KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK ADVISED HIM THAT JAMES HAD GONE THROUGH HER CELLULAR PHONE WHEN SHE WAS ASLEEP AND THIS IS WHY HE RECEIVED THE CALLS FROM JAMES. CRIDDLE STATED HE HAD NEVER PERSONALLY MET JAMES.

CRIDDLE ADVISED HE HAS KNOWN KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO TO TWO AND ONE-HALF YEARS. HE MET AND BECAME FRIENDS WITH HER WHEN SHE WORKED AT MILLER. CRIDDLE IS A TRUCK DRIVER AND AN ASSISTANT PASTOR. CRIDDLE BEGAN DATING KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR AFTER THEY MET. CRIDDLE STATED THAT KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK DATED JAMES PRIOR TO THEIR RELATIONSHIP. CRIDDLE ALSO STATED THAT HE AND KIMBERLY SATTERWHITE YORK ARE STILL CLOSE FRIENDS AND THAT HE TALKS TO HER APPROXIMATELY EVERY OTHER DAY.
