**Administration Division**  
Vicki Skinner, Director

Provides budget development and oversight, accounting, personnel, purchasing, planning, records management, information technology, legal staff support, grant, interlocal, facilities and other business support services.

**Trial Bureau**  
Buddy Meyer, Director

Oversees the operations of the interrelated Grand Jury/Intake and Courts Divisions. Coordinates the development and implementation of targeted programs involving close communication between those divisions.

**Appellate Division**  
Bryan Case, Director

Represents the State of Texas in all appeals arising from criminal convictions, juvenile certifications and the termination of parental rights and responds to prisoner writs of habeas corpus.

**Grand Jury/Intake Division**  
Gary Cobb, Director

Serves as the primary intake division for felony charges. Reviews and screens cases at the filing level and prepares cases for presentation to a Grand Jury. Provides orientation and training for three Grand Juries.

**Family Justice Division**  
LaRu Woody, Director

Responsible for all criminal and civil legal matters within the jurisdiction of the District Attorney's Office regarding children and/or their families and prosecutes domestic violence cases and violation of sex offender registration laws

**Courts Division**  
Robert Smith, Director

Represents the people of the State of Texas and the victims in felony criminal cases pending in the Magistrate, 147th, 167th, 299th, 331st, 390th, 403rd and 427th District Courts.

**Investigation Division**  
Sally Hernandez, Director

Provides litigation investigation support including assisting in case preparation and court presentation; locating, interviewing and subpoenaing victims and witnesses; making arrests; and retrieving and analyzing evidence.

**Strategic Prosecutions Division**  
Dayna Blazey, Director

Responsible for the specialty units: Drug Court prosecutors, Mental Health Felony Prosecution Team, Local White Collar Crime Unit and community-based initiatives. Litigates asset seizures referred by law enforcement and authorizes extraditions.

**Special Prosecution Division**  
Gregg Cox, Director

Investigates and prosecutes criminal activity involving state government, insurance fraud, motor fuels tax fraud and workers' compensation fraud.

**Victim/Witness Division**  
Ellen Halbert, Director

Provides direct services to victims of crime, advocacy for victims' rights, coordination of witness activities and the volunteer program, and education and liaison services.
